Study Tips

- **Spread out study time** over the week; we learn best when practice is spaced
 - If you have 30 minutes to invest, split it over 3 sessions
 - Prioritize reading practice if your time is limited
- Use the QR code to access the **recordings**
- When stuck, review the sounds of the letters and vowels on 1st page
- Set up a study date with a **study-buddy**; keep each other **accountable** by reading together at least once a week

Suggested Study Session #1

- Practice **reading** lines 1-10
 - Listen to the recording and read along
- Practice the **vocabulary**
 - Listen to the recording and read along
 - Test yourself – cover up the Hebrew and translate
- Practice **writing**
 - Letters: aleph & nun

Suggested Study Session #2

- Practice **reading** lines 11-14
 - Listen to the recording and read along
- Practice the **vocabulary** (round 2)
 - Listen to the recording and read along
 - Test yourself – cover up the Hebrew and translate
- Practice **writing**
 - Letters: mem, tav & hey

Suggested Study Session #3

- Practice **reading** lines 11-14
 - Listen to the recording and read along
- Practice **vocabulary** and **writing**
 - Complete the exercises
 - Check your work

Bonus Study Session #4 – for the serious student

- Read the **Introduction – History, Alphabet, Book features**
 - Write notes in the margin about things that you find interesting
 - Write questions in the margin about things that are unclear or you want to know more about
- Make **flashcards** with the vocabulary and/or letters and vowels
